rowing up, Catherine Shanahan's mom said she should become a therapist. Friends came to her for advice, and much like her mother and grandmother, she was known to be a particularly good judge of character—rather an old soul. However, as far as career choices, she didn't even come close to her mother's aspirations. Licensed in Pennsylvania as a Financial Advisor in 1988, Shanahan married, raised five children, worked part time in the financial sector, and when her marriage ended 23 years later in divorce, her attorney asked her a question that ultimately brought Shanahan full circle.
